Pennsylvania Disclosure Statement and Terms of Service

This Disclosure Statement, the Terms and Conditions and the enrollment agreement entered into between Raava Energy ("Supplier", "we" or "us") and [INSERT CUSTOMER NAME AND ADDRESS] ("Customer", "you" or "your") shall constitute an agreement ("Agreement") for electric generation services between Supplier and Customer.

Terms of Service

Background

Supplier is licensed by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("PUC") to offer electric generation services in Pennsylvania.

- PUC electric license number: ______
 Customer's electricity generation prices and charges will be set by Supplier. The Federal Energy
- Customer's electricity generation prices and charges will be set by Supplier. The Federal Energy Regulatory Commission regulates electricity transmission prices and services. The Public Utility Commission regulates distribution prices and services.
- Customer will continue to receive one bill from its Electric Distribution Company ("EDC") for all
 electricity supply and delivery charges. Customer's EDC will continue to provide all emergency
 repairs and services. Supplier is not affiliated with and does not represent any EDC.
- Notwithstanding any language to the contrary, the terms set forth in the following Disclosure Statement take precedence over any conflicting language in these Terms of Service.

Right of Rescission

Customer may rescind the Agreement within three (3) business days after receiving the Agreement. Customer may do this by either notifying us in writing at Raava Energy, 3 School Street, Suite 101B, Glen Cove, New York 11542 or by calling us at (844) 344-2672 and informing us that Customer would like to rescind the Agreement.

1. Definitions

- "Basic Services" The services necessary for the physical delivery of electricity, including Generation supply and Transmission.
- "Customer" or "you" or "your" The person subscribing to Supplier's services and with whom we enter into the Agreement. This includes a person we reasonably believe is acting with the authority or knowledge of the person whose name is on the applicable account.
- "Generation Charge" The charge for producing electricity. Generation service is competitively priced and is not regulated by the Public Utility Commission. If you purchase electricity from an electric supplier, your generation charge will depend on the contract between you and your supplier.
- o "Parties" Supplier and Customer.
- o "Renewal Term(s)" has the meaning set forth in Section 2.
- "Transmission Charge" The cost for transporting electricity from the generation source to your electric distribution company. For most electric customers who select a new supplier, transmission costs will be included from your new supplier. The Federal Energy Regulatory Commission regulates retail transmission prices and services. This charge will vary with your source of supply.

2. Terms of Service

Basic Service Prices - Electric Generation

- <u>Fixed Price Agreement-You</u> will pay a fixed price of __cents per kWh during the term of the Agreement.
- o <u>Variable Rate Agreement-</u> You will pay a variable price that can change monthly. The price for the first billing period (the "Initial Term") will be [INSERT SUPPLIER PRICE) and the price shall each month thereafter (each such month, a "Renewal Term") reflect Supplier's cost of electricity obtained from all sources (including energy, capacity, settlement, ancillaries), related Transmission and Distribution charges and other market-related factors.

There is no price ceiling on a variable rate and no limit on the amount by which Customer's rate may change from one billing cycle to the next. Customer will not be advised of the variable rate during any Renewal Term until Customer receives the bill. No price history or representative price information is available for Supplier's variable rate product.

Both fixed prices and variable prices include estimated total state taxes, including gross receipts taxes, but exclude applicable state and local sales tax.

3. Length of Agreement

- Fixed Term Agreement. The term will begin on the date set by the EDC and will continue for months (or billing cycles).
- Variable Rate Agreement. This Agreement will begin on the date set by the EDC and continue month-to-month, unless cancelled by either party.

4. Cancellation Provisions

- Company-Initiated Cancellation: If Supplier cancels this Agreement for any reason other than for Customer non-payment, Supplier will provide 30-days advance written notice to Customer.
- Customer-Initiated Cancellation If you cancel this Agreement before the end of the initial term, you will owe us for amounts unpaid up to the date of cancellation.
- Customer-Initiated Cancellation You can cancel this Agreement at any time by calling us or using our website. Please see the contact information in Section 12 for our contact information.
- Customer Move If the Customer moves from the address listed above to another Utility service territory, this Agreement is cancelled.
- o Cancellation is effective on a date set by your EDC.

Supplier may cancel the Agreement for any non-payment or any other breach of the Agreement upon 30 days' prior written notice to Customer of such cancellation. If Customer fails to cure within the 30-day notice period, we may cancel the Agreement even if Customer subsequently cures the non-payment or breach after such period has expired. Supplier may also cancel the Agreement after providing the required regulatory notice to Customer due to a change in law or other act beyond Supplier's reasonable control or if we are no longer able to serve Customer.

To cancel the Agreement, Customer must notify Supplier at the contact details set forth in Section 12 below or the EDC in accordance with the notice procedures provided by the EDC. Please provide your name, address, phone number, account number and a statement that Customer is cancelling this Agreement. Cancellation will be processed immediately but is effective upon your EDC processing your cancellation and Customer is obligated to pay for the electric commodity supply provided pursuant to this Agreement until Customer is returned to the EDC or another electric generation supplier, as applicable.

- 5. Early Cancellation Fees. CUSTOMERS WILL NOT BE CHARGED ANY EARLY CANCELLATION FEE FOR EARLY CANCELLATION OR IF WE CANCEL THIS AGREEMENT AS A RESULT OF ANY NON-PAYMENT OR OTHER BREACH OF THIS AGREEMENT OR IF CUSTOMER PROVIDES ANY FALSE, INACCURATE OR MISLEADING INFORMATION.
- Billing and Payment. Customer will receive a single bill from the EDC which will include both the EDC's charges and Supplier's charges.
- 7. Agreement Expiration / Change in Terms. If Customer has a Fixed Term Agreement with us and it is approaching the expiration date, or whenever we propose to change the terms of service, Customer will receive two (2) separate written notifications from us, the first approximately 45 to 60 days in advance and the second 30 days in advance of either the expiration date or the effective date of the proposed changes. These notifications will explain your options going forward. Customer will not be subject to a penalty or fee if the Customer cancels the Agreement at any time between the date the options notice is issued and the expiration of the Agreement.

For a Variable Rate Agreement, if Supplier wants to change the Agreement, you will receive two separate notices before the changes happen. You will receive the first notice 45-60 days before the change, and the second notice 30 days before the change. These notices will explain your options.

- 8. Dispute Procedures. Contact us with any questions concerning our terms of service at the contact information below. If Customer is still not satisfied after discussing the terms within the Agreement, Customer may call the PUC at the contact information set forth in Section 12 below.
- 9. Contract Assignment. You may not assign this Agreement without the prior written consent of Supplier. Supplier reserves the right to sell, transfer, pledge or assign this Agreement and your account, and related revenues and proceeds for financial purposes or in connection with a sale. Prior to any assignment to a new EGS, you will be provided with a 30-day notice of the name of the new EGS, the contact information for the new EGS and the estimated month and year that the assignment is expected to occur. Your Agreement terms and conditions will not change in the event of an assignment to a new EGS.

10. Consent to Obtain Customer Information.

- o You authorize Supplier to obtain your Customer Information from your EDC. For purposes hereof, "Customer Information" means account contact information, account number, meter number, historical and future electricity usage, meter readings and characteristics of your electricity service. It includes information obtained from the EDC as well as any information that you provide directly to Supplier or its agents.
- Supplier will maintain the confidentiality of your Customer Information, including your name, address, telephone number, electric usage, and historic payment information, as required by applicable Commission regulations and Federal and State laws.
- 11. Dispute Procedure. Contact Supplier with any questions concerning our terms of service. Rescission Right	You have the right, for three (3) business days from the date you receive this Disclosure Statement, to rescind this Agreement. You may exercise this this right of rescission by contacting the Supplier in writing or telephonically at the contact details set forth next to the Supplier Information above.
