In lieu of the applicable rates provided for in Tariff Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 50 for the above carrier, the following hourly rates shall apply for shipments traveling between points in Pennsylvania and transported distances of forty (40) miles and less from origin to destination.

Subject to Notes 1-5 below, the transportation charges on any shipment shall be a COMBINATION of the applicable TRAVELING CHARGE plus the HOURLY CHARGE as shown below.

Travel Charge is based on the total mileage from carrier's facility to first point of origin and from final destination back to carrier's facility.

0 - 30 miles = 1 hour	31 - 50 miles = 1 1/2 hours
51 - 70 miles = 2 hours	71 - 90 miles = 2 1/2 hours
91 - 100 miles = 3 hours	111 - 130 miles = 4 hours

▲ **NOTE 1 - MINIMUM TRANSPORTATION CHARGES:** Sundays & Holidays (any hour): 4 hours plus applicable travel charge.
Monday-Saturday (any hour) and Friday & Saturday (any hour): 2 hours plus applicable travel charge

NOTE 2 - When a shipment is not unloaded, at the convenience of the customer, and remains on the carrier's vehicle overnight, a charge of \$100.00 per vehicle per night will be assessed. Hourly rates as shown above will be assessed and applied to the next day.

NOTE 3 - A pre-paid deposit for 2 hours based on number of vehicles and men at rates shown above is required at time the move is scheduled. Deposit will be refunded if move is cancelled 48 hours or more in advance of the move date. If move is cancelled less than 48 hours in advance of the move date, deposit will not be refunded.

NOTE 4 - BULKY ITEMS:

Spinet Piano (0-1 FLOORS) - origin & destination combined - \$50.00 per piano

Upright Piano (0-1 FLOORS) - origin & destination combined - \$100.00 per piano

Each additional floor for either type piano adds \$50.00 to the total charge, up to a maximum of \$300.00.

Carrier reserves the right to refuse moving a piano if deemed unsafe.

Player Piano, Baby Grand Piano, Organ (NO FLIGHT OR STEPS) - \$200.00 per piano

Carrier reserves the right to refuse moving a larger piano if steps are involved. Customer will be referred to a qualified piano mover.

Gun Safe, Fireproof Cabinet or other heavy pieces without adequate holds - 300-500 pounds

piece - \$100.00 per item; greater than 500 pounds - \$250.00 per item

Carrier reserves the right to remove an item of this kind if conditions are deemed unsafe for the moving crew. Flights or steps with heavy pieces listed above - \$50.00 per flight per item.

Other Bulky Items - greater than 500 pounds - \$250.00 per item

Carrier reserves the right to refuse moving a bulky item if conditions are deemed unsafe for the moving crew. Flights or steps with bulky item >500 pounds - \$50.00 per flight per item.

Pool Table (NON-SLATE) - no charge

Pool Table (SLATE - 3 pieces only - disassembled) - \$100.00 per pool table

Carrier does not move single piece slate pool tables.

Exercise Equipment/Treadmill - Carrier does not charge extra for moving exercise equipment;

however, home gyms must be dismantled by the customer prior to moving. If not, carrier reserves the right to refuse moving the home gym. Carrier does not reassemble home gyms.

NOTE 5 - Carrier reserves the right to require a minimum of a 4-men crew on any move if conditions are deemed unsafe for a 2-men or 3-men crew to complete the move.
