Re: Supplement No. 334 to Tariff Electric PA. P.U.C. No. 201 for Net Metering for Renewable Customer-Generators

Dear Mr. Shafer:

On March 17, 2022, PPL Electric Utilities Corporation (the Company) filed Supplement No. 334 to Tariff Electric - Pa. P.U.C. No. 201 with an effective date of February 24, 2022. Supplement No. 334 was filed in accordance with the February 24, 2022 Commission withdrawal of its policy statement announced in its final order at Net Metering – Use of Third-Party Operators, Docket No. M-2011-2249441 (Order entered March 29, 2012). Third-party owned and operated systems will no longer be limited to 110% of the customer-generator’s annual consumption. Relevant language pertaining to this limitation has been removed from the tariff and became effective February 24, 2022.

Commission Staff has reviewed the tariff revisions and found that suspension or further investigation does not appear warranted at this time. Therefore, in accordance with 52 Pa. Code Chapter 53, Supplement No. 334 to Tariff Electric - Pa. P.U.C. No. 201 is effective by operation of law as of the effective date contained on each page of the supplement. However, this is without prejudice to any formal complaints timely filed against said tariff revisions.
