The Bureau of Audits has reviewed Philadelphia Gas Works' quarterly Distribution System Improvement Charge (DSIC) filing submitted on March 21, 2022. In the filing, the company is not proposing to revise its currently effective DSIC rate of 7.50%.

Based upon staff review, it appears that the DSIC rate for the three-month period of April 1, 2022 through June 30, 2022 is consistent with the tariff and, accordingly, is permitted to become effective as filed.

The DSIC is subject to continuous Commission review and audit as well as reconciliation reports in accordance with Section 1307(e) of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. § 1307(e).
