Respondent:

On May 17, 2021, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement instituted a Complaint at C-2022-3025901 against **AAA CAB COMPANY t/a POTTSTOWN CAB CO t/a PHOENIXVILLE CAB CO**, Respondent, alleging that Respondent, by failing to display a current inspection sticker, violated 52 Pa. Code § 29.405; by failing to display the number of the certificate of public convenience, violated 52 Pa. Code § 29.71(a); by failing to display the number of the taxicab, violated 52 Pa. Code § 29.71(c); by permitting a vehicle to be operated that was not equipped with a meter violated 52 Pa. Code § 29.314(b)(1); by permitting a vehicle to be operated that did not have a dome light affixed to roof, violated 52 Pa. Code § 29.314(d); by failing to post the Commission-issued complaint decal, violated 52 Pa. Code § 29.318; by failing to require the driver to maintain a trip sheet, violated 52 Pa. Code § 29.335; by failing to maintain fare receipts, violated 52 Pa. Code § 29.313(f); by failing to post the rates of fare in the vehicle, violated 52 Pa. Code § 29.316(a)(1)(i); by permitting persons to provide transport services before obtaining and reviewing a criminal history report, violated 52 Pa. Code § 29.505(b)(1); and by permitting persons to provide transport services before obtaining and reviewing a driver history report, violated 52 Pa. Code § 29.504(b)(1).

The Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement notified Respondent that it must file an Answer to the Complaint in accordance with 52 Pa. Code §5.61, within twenty (20) days of the date of service. The Notice further specified that, if Respondents failed to answer the Complaint within twenty days, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement would request the Commission to issue a letter fining Respondents the sum of Two Thousand, Eight Hundred Fifty dollars (\$2850.00).

The Complaint was served on Respondent, **AAA CAB COMPANY t/a POTTSTOWN CAB CO t/a PHOENIXVILLE CAB CO**, by Certified Mail on February 16, 2022, and was returned unclaimed on March 24, 2022. The Complaint was sent for publication in the PABulletin on March 5, 2022 with a response due by March 21, 2022. To date, no response has been received from Respondent.

Respondent is assessed a fine of Two Thousand Eight Hundred Fifty dollars (\$2850.00) for failure to comply with the provisions of 75 Pa. Code and 52 Pa. Code. Payment must be made by certified check or money order payable to the Commonwealth of PA, and mailed to PA Public Utility Commission, 400 North Street, Harrisburg, PA 17120.

Respondent is hereby notified to cease and desist from further violations of the Public Utility Code, 75 Pa. Code §§1.1 et seq. and the regulations of the Commission, 52 Pa. Code §§1.1 et seq.

APPEAL RIGHTS

If you disagree with this determination, you may send a Petition for Reconsideration from Staff Action (Petition) to: Secretary, PA Public Utility Commission, 400 North Street, Harrisburg, PA 17120. Such a Petition is a written statement asking the Commission to change its determination.

The Petition must be filed with the Commission within twenty (20) days of the date of this letter. If no timely request for reconsideration is made, this action will be deemed to be the final action of the Commission.

The Petition MUST include: (1) a written statement (divided into numbered paragraphs) outlining the reasons for the request, (2) the case docket number(s) (they are provided for you at the top right hand corner of this letter), (3) the name of the person on whose behalf the petition is made, (4) copies of relevant documentation, and (5) a verification with original signature. *See* 52 Pa. Code §§1.31 and 5.44. Below is a sample Verification:


