Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

Enclosed please find Duquesne Light Company's reports pursuant to 66 Pa. C.S. §§ 1410.1(3) and 1410.1(4) regarding residential accounts with balances in excess of \$10,000 and medical certificates for the calendar year 2021.

The number of medical certificates applied in 2021 is significantly higher than 2020 due to the easing of the emergency moratorium on terminations. However, the number remains lower than pre-2020 years, which in part can be attributed to customers being entitled to one additional payment arrangement in 2021. As such, many customers did not need medical certificates.

The number of accounts with balances over \$10k is significantly higher than it was prior to 2020, due to the global coronavirus pandemic and the emergency moratorium on terminations (Emergency Order issued March 13, 2020, Docket No. M-2020-3019244).
