Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

On February 11, 2022, the Commission issued a Secretarial Letter inviting interested parties to submit Comments and Reply Comments to additional information requested by the Commission related to the UGI Utilities, Inc. (UGI or the Company) Universal Service and Energy Conservation Plan for 2020 - 2025 (UGI's USECP or Plan). On February 22, 2022, UGI responded to the February Secretarial Letter, providing additional requested information.

On March 4, 2022, the Coalition for Affordable Utility Services and Energy Efficiency in Pennsylvania (CAUSE-PA), through its attorneys at the Pennsylvania Utility Law Project, filed brief comments asserting that the information and data provided in UGI's response to the February Secretarial Letter reasonably addressed and resolved outstanding questions posed by the Commission. Further, CAUSE-PA found the supplemental data did not indicate material differences in costs to implement the proposed amended PIP energy burdens for UGI's customer assistance program (CAP).

On March 30, 2022, UGI filed Corrected Responses to the Company's February 22nd response to the February Secretarial Letter. UGI reviewed the Corrected Responses with CAUSE-PA and with the Office of Consumer Advocate (OCA) prior to filing with the Commission. As noted in UGI's filing, CAUSE-PA's position remains unchanged and agrees that no additional comment period is necessary for this proceeding.

Thus, CAUSE-PA urges the Commission to approve UGI's Amended USECP without delay, in a manner consistent with our previously submitted Comments and Reply Comments.
