Re: Application to Renew Registration as a Conservation Service Provider

Dear Mr. Yanchek:

On March 28, 2022, Key Recycling, LLC filed an incomplete application to renew register as a Conservation Service Provider (CSP) with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission. On April 8, 2022, Key Recycling, LLC filed documents to complete the application. A CSP must renew registration every two years to remain on the registry. The most recent registration for Key Recycling, LLC is April 27, 2020.


A registered CSP can advise an electric distribution company (EDC) and/or provide consultation, design, administration, or management services to an EDC related to the EDC's energy efficiency and conservation plan. Upon review, it appears that the applicant continues to meet the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's minimum qualifications to provide consultation, design, administration, management, or advisory services to an EDC regarding energy efficiency and conservation plans required under Act 129 of 2008, P.L. 1592.

Therefore, effective April 27, 2022, registration for Key Recycling, LLC with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's Registry of Conservation Service Providers is renewed for two more years with a new **expiration date of April 27, 2024**. In addition, the applicant is advised that if any information in the application changes, a written notice of said change shall be filed with the Commission within 45 days of the change.

This approval is not meant to constitute a license, certification, or warranty of any kind by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission.
