SECTION 1
RULES & REGULATIONS

▲ RULE NO. 1 - GOVERNING PUBLICATIONS

Shipments moving 40 miles and under and shipments moving in excess of 40 miles are governed, except as otherwise provided herein by Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 1 issued by the carrier, supplements thereto and reissues thereof.

ADDITIONAL SERVICES

Rates and charges for additional services shown herein are in addition to all other rates. Rates and charges apply on shipments when released to a value not exceeding 60 cents per pound per article. For rates to apply on shipments where the declared value exceeds 60 cents per pound per article, see Item 290 in Governing Publications (Rule 1 above).

ITEM 10 - PACKING AND UNPACKING (Exception to Item 200 of Governing Publication)

The charges and provisions of Item 200 apply as published except for the following:

Carrier will perform packing and unpacking at the direction of the shipper/receiver and the charge will be the cost of the container (see Item 40) plus the hourly rate shown on Table A of Page 4 of this tariff for the labor used.

ITEM 20 - HOISTING OR LOWERING (where necessary)

Flat charge of \$60.00 per article.

ITEM 30 - PIANO OR ORGAN CARRY CHARGES

1. HANDLING CHARGE - Flat Charge per piano

SCHEDULE OF RATES - TABLE A

(Applicable on all shipments transported 40 miles and less)

Subject to Notes 1 to 6 below, the transportation charges on any shipment shall be a COMBINATION of the applicable TRAVELING CHARGE shown in Column 1 plus the HOURLY CHARGE at applicable rates named in Columns 2, 3 and 4.

Hourly rates apply only from time of arrival of vehicles and men at first point of origin (continue during all loading, transportation from first point of origin to final destination, including any extra stops, and unloading) until completion of unloading and dismissal of vehicles and men by shipper at destination.

Traveling charges cover traveling to first point of origin and traveling from final destination; irrespective of actual time involved in such traveling.

NOTE 1 - Traveling charge (Column 1) is in addition to Hourly Rates (Columns 2, 3 and 4).

NOTE 2 - Hourly Rates (Columns 2, 3 and 4) are based on the day or days as indicated.

NOTE 3 - Hourly Rates (Columns 2, 3 and 4) computed in 1/4 hour periods - fraction of 1/4 hour considered as 1/4 hour.

NOTE 4 - When a holiday falls on a Saturday, the rates named in Columns 1 and 2 apply.

NOTE 5 - Minimum Transportation Charges: Monday-Friday (except holidays): four (4) hours at rates named in Column 3; Saturdays: six (6) hours at rates named in Column 4; and Sundays & Holidays: eight (8) hours at rates named in Column 2.

NOTE 6 - Carrier will supply and charge for supervisor(s) as requested by shipper or required by carrier. Hourly rate for each supervisor will be computed from time of arrival of vehicles and men at first point of origin until completion of unloading and dismissal of vehicle and men at final destination unless other time of arrival or dismissal of supervisor is provided by agreement between the shipper and the carrier.

NOTE AA - Travel charge to be based on the applicable transportation rates shown in Columns 2, 3, and 4 and will apply as follows based on the combined actual road miles from the carrier's terminal to the first point of origin and from the final destination back to carrier's terminal using Mileage Guide No. 40 or a software program designed to calculate mileage, such as, Google Maps, MapQuest, or TruckRouter.

0 - 20 miles	1 hour
21 - 35 miles	1 1/2 hours
36 - 50 miles	2 hours

For mileage in excess of 50 miles, a travel time charge of 1/2 hour will be assessed for each additional 15 miles.

LOCAL FUEL COST RECOVERY CHARGE

The following Fuel Cost Recovery Surcharge will apply as follows on shipments of household goods in use, between points in Pennsylvania, transported distances of forty (40) miles and less.

- (a) The Fuel Cost Recovery Surcharge will be calculated using a "BASE PRICE PER GALLON" of \$1.267.
- (b) On the first Monday of each calendar month, the "CENTRAL ATLANTIC" average price per gallon of diesel fuel will be determined based on the price stated by the U. S. Department of Energy (DOE), Energy Information Administration (EIA) survey of "Retail-On-Highway Diesel Prices." This price will be obtained by calling the DOE Fuel Hot Line at 202-586-6966 or via the DOE Internet Website at www.eia.doe.gov.
- (c) If the first Monday of the calendar month is a federal holiday, the price will be determined based on the stated DOE price available on the next subsequent business day (Tuesday).
- (d) The DOE fuel price obtained will then become effective on the fifteenth (15th) day of the same month. The adjustment determined will apply for shipments loaded beginning on the 15th day of the month and remain in effect through the 14th day of the subsequent following month starting from the effective date of this item.

THIS PROCESS WILL CONTINUE MONTH AFTER MONTH BASED ON THE "NEW" MONTHLY FUEL COSTS.

FOR EXAMPLE

If the reported price of self-service diesel fuel determined on Monday, 10/01/2018, is \$3.447 per gallon, that amount will apply for the purpose of calculating the difference between that amount and the base price of \$1.267 per gallon for shipments loaded as of October 15, 2018 to November 14, 2018.

TO DETERMINE THE FUEL ADJUSTMENT AMOUNT TO APPLY, FIRST DETERMINE THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE "BASE PRICE PER GALLON" AND THE MOST CURRENT SELF-SERVICE DIESEL FUEL PRICE PER GALLON.

Rates and charges apply on shipments when released to a value not exceeding 60 cents per pound per article. The rates shown apply to moves originating in the Counties of Bucks & Montgomery traveling in excess of 40 miles to points in Pennsylvania.

NOTE 3 - Charge will be based on weight at which the transportation rate is based, EXCEPT, when provision in NOTE 2 is applicable.

NOTE 4 - Corporate limits of points partly within a county will be considered as wholly within a county.

TRANSPORTATION RATES

(Applicable on all shipments transported in excess of 40 miles)

Rates are in cents per 100 pounds, apply to actual weight (subject to minimum weights as provided in rules herein) and include loading and unloading and the actual movement or transportation of property from origin to destination, but do not include Additional Services and Charges shown on other pages of this tariff. These rates apply to moves transported between points in Pennsylvania and traveling distances in excess of 40 miles.

Break Point indicates weight at which a lower charge develops by use of lowest weight and applicable rate in next higher weight bracket.
