On January 13, 2022, PECO filed a Letter of Notification (“LON”) requesting approval to replace five transmission structures on the 130-54 transmission line in East Fallowfield Township and Coatesville, Chester County, Pennsylvania that are at end of life. The Commission issued an Order approving the filing on April 14, 2022.

At the time of filing, the project had a scheduled construction start date of April 25, 2022. The outage for the 130-54 line scheduled to begin in late April has been postponed and is estimated to be rescheduled for late 2022. The cause is a recent transformer failure at the Bradford substation, which feeds the 130-52 line. With the 130-52 line out of service, PECO is unable to proceed with the April 130-54 outage, as the 130-54 line is now the only remaining transmission line feeding one of PECO’s large customers. PECO will provide the Commission with an updated 130-54 outage date when it is scheduled.
