Your application has been reviewed and it has been determined that a certificate of public convenience with **PUC No. A-8924011** shall issue only upon compliance; Therefore,

YOU ARE ADVISED to contact your insurance agent/broker so that the required evidence of permanent insurance will be filed with this Commission, ONLINE ONLY, via NIC Insurance Filings, at www.nicinsurancefilings.com.

A certificate of public convenience will be issued UPON THE FILING OF PERMANENT PROOF OF INSURANCE and compliance with any other provision of this letter:

- a. **An acceptable Form E and Form H** filed by an insurance company which is binding evidence of bodily injury and property damage liability insurance. **Your insurance company must file these forms with the exact name of the applicant as it appears on this Letter – All One Auto Service, Inc., t/a All One Auto. The State MC ID A-8924011 must be listed to identify your account. All service types covered by this policy must be listed.**
- b. Should you be eligible for a **Cargo Waiver**, please e-mail it to taroth@pa.gov. You will not submit a **Form H**.

APPLICANTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR MONITORING THEIR ACCOUNT ONLINE. You can do this by visiting the following web address: <https://www.puc.pa.gov/search/utility-authority-search/>. Enter your company name, click submit, then click on your utility code hyperlink. Navigate to the “Insurance Info” tab, where you can view accepted forms.

Upon the filing of acceptable permanent proof of insurance, and upon compliance with any other provision of this letter, a certificate of public convenience will be issued authorizing the right to operate as follows:

*To transport, as a motor common carrier, property, **excluding household goods in use**, between points in Pennsylvania.*

FAILURE TO FILE THE REQUIRED EVIDENCE OF INSURANCE AND/OR COMPLY WITH ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS LETTER WITHIN SIXTY (60) DAYS OF THE DATE OF THIS LETTER CAN RESULT IN THE DISMISSAL OF THE APPLICATION AND REQUIRE THE FILING OF A NEW APPLICATION AND FILING FEE.


If you have not previously submitted a copy of a current satisfactory safety rating from the U.S. Department of Transportation or another state with safety regulations comparable to Pennsylvania, you must demonstrate safety fitness by completing a Safety Fitness Review which will be scheduled by a PUC enforcement officer within 180 days of the date your certificate of public convenience is issued/entered. **Failure to submit to the Safety Fitness Review will result in the cancellation of your certificate.** An overview of the safety regulations for carriers of people, property, and household goods between points in Pennsylvania can be found on the PUC's Website: <http://www.puc.pa.gov/> then select: Filing & Resources, Forms, Motor Carrier Forms, Safety Fitness Compliance.

The applicant is hereby advised of its obligation to familiarize itself with the requirements of 52 Pa. Code as applicable to the operation of a common carrier as authorized by this Secretarial Letter. Applicant is further advised that failure to comply with all applicable requirements may subject the carrier to penalties, including fines, suspension of operating rights or cancellation of its authority. Any PUC motor carrier who needs to submit a change of address to the Public Utility Commission, can obtain the Change of Address form from the PUC Website: <http://www.puc.pa.gov/> then select: Filing & Resources, Forms, Motor Carrier Forms.

ALL Parties to proceedings pending before the Commission must open and use an e-filing account through the Commission's website, OR you may submit your filing by overnight delivery. If a filing contains confidential or proprietary material, the filing is required to be submitted by overnight delivery.
