The Bureau of Audits has reviewed Duquesne Light Company's proposed rate and supporting rate computations submitted on April 1, 2022. The supporting rate computations indicate that the rate will remain unchanged; therefore, the company did not file a tariff supplement.

Based upon staff review, it appears that the proposed Retail Market Enhancement Surcharge (RMES) rates for the twelve-month period of June 1, 2022 through May 31, 2023 are consistent with the tariff and, accordingly, are permitted to remain effective as filed.

The RMES is subject to continuous Commission review and audit as well as reconciliation reports in accordance with Section 1307(e) of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. § 1307(e).
