By Secretarial Letter dated March 11, 2015, the Commission sustained a complaint and cancelled the authority of Penn Trans Shuttle LLC at Case Docket No. C-2020-3022796 and assessed a fine of \$500.00 for failure to maintain evidence of insurance on file with this Commission as required at 52 Pa. Code §32, as well as a fine in the amount of \$100.00 for failing to file an answer to the Complaint as required by 52 Pa. Code §5.61, for a total fine of \$600.00. Payment of this fine has been received and is satisfied.

This Commission has the power to rescind a Secretarial Letter in light of newly discovered evidence or a change of circumstances which justify reconsideration. It has come to our attention that the Complaint was not properly served at Case Docket No. C-2020-3022796, with this Commission.

Therefore, the Certificate of Public Convenience at Docket No. A-2011-2278262, Utility Code A-6414132, will be reinstated upon compliance with the following:

- a) submission of a new Form E for Liability Insurance.**
- b) Submission of address change form**
- c) Submission of 2021 assessment report**


