1. Reference the Agreement, Paragraph 2. Please explain whether there are any costs associated with subject distribution upgrades which will not be refunded by Allegheny County to Duquesne Light.

Response:

All costs associated with the distribution upgrades and direct connection of the Allegheny County (“customer”) generation interconnection, except the Duquesne Light Company provided bidirectional meter, will be the cost responsibility of the customer. As indicated on page 2 of the Agreement, the costs of distribution upgrades are allocated to the customer pursuant to Title 52 of the Pennsylvania Code, Chapter 75.
