Dear Mr. Zimmerman:

The Bureau of Audits has reviewed Duquesne Light Company's proposed Supplement No. 44 to Tariff Electric-Pa. P.U.C. No. 25 and the supporting rate computations submitted on April 1, 2022 to become effective on June 1, 2022.

Based upon staff review, it appears that the proposed Default Service Supply (DSS) rates for the Residential & Lighting and Small Commercial & Industrial classes for the six-month period of June 1, 2022 through November 30, 2022; and for the Medium Commercial & Industrial classes for the three-month period of June 1, 2022 through August 31, 2022 are consistent with the tariff and, accordingly, are permitted to become effective as filed.

Based upon staff review, it appears that the proposed Electric Vehicle Time-Of-Use (EV-TOU) supply rates for the Residential and Small Commercial & Industrial classes for the six-month period of June 1, 2022 through November 30, 2022; and for the Medium Commercial & Industrial classes for the three-month period of June 1, 2022 through August 31, 2022 are consistent with the tariff and, accordingly, are permitted to become effective as filed.

The DSS is subject to continuous Commission review and audit as well as reconciliation reports in accordance with Section 1307(e) of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. § 1307(e).
