4. The Complainant is authorized and directed by the Small Business Advocate Act, Act 181 of 1988, 73 P.S. §§ 399.41 - 399.50, to represent the interests of small business consumers of utility services in matters before the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("Commission").

5. This Complaint is filed against the rates, terms and other provisions of Supplement No. 152 to Tariff Electric-Pa. P.U.C. No. 14, which was filed on April 29, 2022 by Citizens' Electric Company of Lewisburg, PA ("Citizens'" or the "Company"). The proposed Tariff, if approved by the Commission, would increase the total distribution revenues of Citizens' by \$999,270 per year, a 7.11% increase in annual distribution revenues.<sup>1</sup> After preliminary review of the materials filed by the Company in support of the proposed Supplement, Complainant believes, and therefore avers, that those materials may be insufficient to justify the rate increase requested and that the Company's present and proposed rates, rules, and conditions of service may be unjust, unreasonable, unduly discriminatory, and otherwise contrary to law, particularly as they pertain to small business customers.

6. Complainant believes, and therefore avers, that Citizens' proposed rates, rate design, and class revenue allocation are or may be unjust, unreasonable, and unlawfully discriminatory in violation of, *inter alia*, Sections 1301 and 1304 of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa.C.S. §§1301 and 1304, and contrary to appropriate public policy and sound ratemaking considerations, and may not be supported by the materials filed by Citizens'.

7. In view of the foregoing, the Small Business Advocate respectfully requests that the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission:

- A. Suspend and investigate the operation of Supplement No. 152 to Tariff
   Electric-Pa. P.U.C. No. 14;
- B. At the conclusion of such investigation, reject the proposed new rates and other tariff changes in Supplement No. 152 to Tariff Electric-Pa. P.U.C.
  No. 14 to the extent required to ensure that Citizens' rates are lawful, just, reasonable and not unduly discriminatory to any class of customers; and
- C. Grant such other relief as may be necessary or appropriate.

#### PUBLIC STATEMENT OF SMALL BUSINESS ADVOCATE

The Small Business Advocate is authorized and directed to represent the interests of small business consumers of utility services in Pennsylvania under the provisions of the Small Business Advocate Act 181 of 1988, 73 P.S. §§ 399.41 – 399.50 ("the Act"). The Act further provides that the Small Business Advocate issue publicly a written statement stating concisely the specific interest of small business consumers to be protected by the initiation of or intervention in any proceeding involving those interests before the Public Utility Commission ("Commission") or any other agency or court. This public statement relates to the filing today by the Small Business Advocate of a Complaint against proposed Supplement No. 152 to Tariff Electric – Pa. P.U.C. No. 14 ("Supplement No. 152") of Citizens' Electric Company of Lewisburg, Inc. ("Citizens"").

Citizens' proposed Supplement No. 152 would increase the amount of distribution revenues collected from all customers, including small business customers, by \$999,270, a 7.11% distribution rate increase.

The Small Business Advocate has filed a formal Complaint against Citizens' proposed

rate increase in order to protect the interests of Citizens' small business customers. A preliminary review of the data filed by Citizens' in support of its request for a rate increase indicates that the costs claimed by Citizens' for ratemaking purposes may be excessive. A thorough inquiry by the Commission into all elements of Citizens' request for a rate increase at this docket is necessary to ensure that Citizens' rates, including any new rates that may result from this proceeding, are just and reasonable.

In view of the foregoing, the Small Business Advocate will participate in proceedings before the Commission to investigate the reasonableness of the proposed rates in Citizens' proposed Supplement No. 152. The Small Business Advocate will ask the Commission to deny any proposed rate increase or other changes in Citizens' present tariffs that apply to small business customers that are not proven by Citizens' to be lawful, just, reasonable and nondiscriminatory to all of its customer classes.
