Re: Municipal Agreement between Duquesne Light Company and Allegheny County, Pennsylvania.

Dear Ms. Farah:


On April 8, 2022, Duquesne Light Company (Duquesne) filed a Guaranty Agreement with Allegheny County which sets forth a payment plan for distribution upgrades. The upgrades are necessary to support the installation of a photovoltaic solar facility in Allegheny County. The total amount to be recovered through the Agreement will be equivalent to the costs incurred by Duquesne and is estimated to be approximately \$166,400. The Agreement was filed pursuant to 66 Pa. C.S. § 507. On April 19, 2022, the Commission initiated a proceeding to review the Agreement pursuant to §507.

Upon review, the Agreement appears to be reasonable and consistent with the public interest and the Agreement is hereby approved. However, approval of the agreement does not preclude the Commission from investigating, during any formal proceeding, the reasonableness of this Guaranty Agreement.

If you are dissatisfied with the resolution of this matter, you may, as set forth in 52 Pa. Code §5.44, file a petition with the Commission within (20) days of the date of this letter.
