INTERIM ORDER FIVE—
GRANTING MOTION TO MAINTAIN OPEN RECORD

Interim Order Four, issued May 15, 2000, granted the motion of Allegheny Power, t/a West Penn Power Company, to have the record remain open until July 30, 2000. Consistent with Interim Order Four, Duquesne Light Company, by letter dated June 29, 2000, advised the presiding ALJ of the status of its restructuring proceeding and its federal court litigation with Allegheny Power. By motion filed on or about July 26, 2000, Allegheny Power asks to have the record remain open until October 31, 2000. The motion represents the activities of the parties as follows:

The parties have exchanged information and have discussed potential avenues outside litigation to resolve the proceeding. Allegheny Power requests that the record remain open so that in the event that a settlement does not occur, it may supplement the record. The additional filing would put the proceeding in the context of the restructured electric industry. The present record, which reflects the proceeding just prior to the electric industry restructuring in late 1996 and early 1997, is extremely out of date.


The motion represents that counsel for Duquesne Light Company supports the motion. It appears that having the record remain open until October 31, 2000, is in the best interest of the parties and the public.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the evidentiary record in *Township of Springdale v. Duquesne Light Company and West Penn Power Company*, at Docket No. C-00967749, shall remain open until October 31, 2000.

2. That on or before October 15, 2000, the parties shall report, in writing, to the presiding ALJ, the results of their efforts to resolve the matters at issue.
