
Changes to this tariff are a **CHANGE** in the verbiage for debris removal, an **INCREASE** in the cost of carton delivery charge, the **ADDITION** of pieces requiring shrink wrapping, an **INCREASE** in the handling charge for grand/concert piano & jacuzzi, an **INCREASE** in the cost of a mirror carton and carton delivery fee, an **INCREASE** in the cost for trash/furniture disposal, an **INCREASE** in the cost of crating, and an **INCREASE** in local hourly rates.

**SECTION 1  
RULES & REGULATIONS**

**ITEM 10 - SCOPE OF CARRIER'S OPERATING AUTHORITY**

To transport, as a motor carrier, household goods in use, between points in Pennsylvania - PA P.U.C. Certificate No. A-00111047.

**ITEM 20 - GOVERNING PUBLICATIONS**

For rates, rules, regulations and provisions applicable to the transportation of HOUSEHOLD GOODS and RELATED ARTICLES, IN USE, except as specifically provided herein, see Tariff Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 53 (Carrier Directory), revisions thereto and reissues thereof, issued by Tristate Household Goods Tariff Conference, Inc., Agent.

**ITEM 30 - DECLARED VALUE**

Rates and charges named herein applicable when value declared by shipper does not exceed 60 cents per pound per article. For method of determining rates when declared value exceeds 60 cents per pound per article, see governing tariff.

**ITEM 40 - FULL VALUE PROTECTION (#)**

When a shipment is moved with Full Value Protection (FVP) coverage, a value must be declared by the Shipper on the Bill of Lading for the entire shipment. The Full Value Protection rates below apply for distances of 40 miles and less and distances over 40 miles. The cost of the Full Value Coverage shall be as follows:

**NOTE A** - Shipper must declare a minimum value of \$6.00 per pound or \$21,000.00, whichever is greater.

**NOTE B** - This coverage shall include items of extraordinary value., if declared. High value inventory is required.

**NOTE C** - When shipper requests Full-Value Protection, an inventory of all items to be transported by the carrier must be completed.

**ITEM 50 - PACKING AND UNPACKING (#)**

Packing and unpacking will be performed on an hourly basis plus the cost of containers (Item 200), and such labor will be charged at labor rates shown in Section 2, Item 300, herein.

SECTION 2  
ADDITIONAL SERVICE CHARGES

▲ ITEM 60 - DEBRIS REMOVAL (#)

When shipper requests carrier to remove debris at the completion of a move on a day other than delivery day, carrier will assess a charge of \$50.00 per hour for a van and one (1) man, subject to a minimum charge of two (2) hours, and subject to a one (1) hour travel charge. The applicable fuel surcharge based on mileage will apply.

◆ ITEM 70 - CARTON DELIVERY (#)

When shipper requests carrier to deliver packing material prior to the move, a flat charge of \$85.00 plus applicable fuel surcharge based on mileage will be assessed in addition to other charges herein.

▲ ITEM 80 - SHRINK WRAPPING OF FURNITURE (#)

When shipper requests carrier to shrink wrap the furniture specified in this item, the following charges will be assessed in addition to other charges herein.

ITEM 90 - OVERNIGHT HOLD ON TRUCK (#)

When Shipper requests carrier to hold shipper's household goods, in use, on vehicle overnight, the shipper will be assessed a flat charge of \$300.00 in addition to other charges herein.

ITEM 95 - PARKING PERMIT (#)

A charge of \$60.00 will be assessed for each forty (40) foot zone. Should customer choose to secure the parking permit themselves, but fail to do so, the customer will be responsible to pay any parking tickets or related fees received by the carrier.

ITEM 100 - BULKY ARTICLES (#)

When the articles specified in this item are a part of a household goods, in use, shipment, they will be subject to the applicable flat charge per item in addition to other charges named herein.

**SECTION 3  
HOURLY RATES**

ITEM 300

Applicable on the transportation of CLASS 1 SHIPMENTS (Item 50) transported distances of forty (40) miles and less.

Subject to Notes 1 to 6 below - The transportation charge on any shipment shall be a COMBINATION of the applicable TRAVELING CHARGE named in Note 5 plus HOURLY CHARGE at applicable rates named in Columns 2, 3 and 4.

Hourly rates apply only from time of arrival of vehicles and men at first point of origin (continue during all loading, transportation from first point of origin to final destination, and unloading) until completion of unloading and dismissal of vehicles and men by shipper at destination.

Traveling charges cover traveling from carrier's terminal to the first point of origin and traveling from final destination back to the carrier's terminal, irrespective of actual time involved in such traveling.

- NOTE 4:** Rates in Column 4 apply only from 5:01PM to 12Midnight on any day when a higher rate is shown for the following day.
- NOTE 5:** Minimum charge: Weekdays (any hour), Saturdays (any hour), Sundays and Holidays (any hour): Three (3) hours labor at the rates named in Columns 2, 3 and 4 plus applicable travel time charge.
- NOTE 6:** A flat travel charge in addition to the hourly labor charges will be assessed as follows:  
 0 - 30 miles - 1 hour    31 - 45 miles - 1 1/2 hours    45 - 60 miles - 2 hours  
 For distances over 60 miles, add 1/2 hour for each additional 15 miles.
