**PPL ELECTRIC’S RESPONSE TO
FOLLOW-UP COMMENTS OF PA CLEEC**

PPL Electric Utilities Corporation (“PPL Electric” or the “Company”) is submitting this response to the Follow-Up Comments of PA CLEEC (“PA CLEEC Comments”), which were filed on May 26, 2022, at Docket No. M-2022-3031727 regarding PPL Electric’s Proposed Universal Service and Energy Conservation Plan for 2023-2027 (“2023-2027 USECP”). The Company filed its 2023-2027 USECP on April 1, 2022, in accordance with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission’s (“PUC” or the “Commission”) October 3, 2019, Order on Universal Service and Energy Conservation Plan (USECP) Filing Schedule and Independent Evaluation Filing Schedule, at Docket No. M-2019-3012601, and 52 Pa. Code § 54.74.

The Commission’s Bureau of Consumer Services scheduled a stakeholder meeting for May 18, 2022, to discuss the Company’s 2023-2027 USECP. PPL Electric and various stakeholders, including PA CLEEC, participated in this stakeholder meeting. During the stakeholder meeting representatives of the Company answered questions about its 2023-2027 USECP and listened to the thoughts and concerns of stakeholders about the proposed plan. Additionally, members of PA CLEEC expressed the group’s positions on the 2023-2027 USECP which were substantially similar to the positions expressed in the PA CLEEC Comments.

In prior proceedings the Commission has requested comments and reply comments from the stakeholders after the issuance of a tentative order, and PPL Electric anticipates a similar procedure for its 2023-2027 USECP.¹ For this reason, the Company reserves all rights to respond to the substance of the PA CLEEC Comments at such time as when the Commission requests all
