
COMPLAINT

The Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) is a duly constituted agency of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania empowered to regulate public utilities within the Commonwealth. The Commission has delegated its authority to initiate proceedings which are prosecutory in nature to the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement and other bureaus with enforcement responsibilities. Pursuant to that delegated authority and Section 701 of the Public Utility Code, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement hereby represents as follows:

1. That KENECHUKWU E ILONZE, t/a ILONZE TRANSPORTATION SERVICES, Respondent, maintains a principal place of business at 417 Dalmás Avenue, Folcroft, Pennsylvania, 19032.
2. On December 8, 2021, Respondent was issued a certificate of public convenience by this Commission to transport, as a common carrier, persons in paratransit service, for nonemergency medical transportation, between points in the Counties of Bucks, Chester, Delaware and Montgomery, and the City and County of Philadelphia; Provided, however, that no right, power, or privilege is granted to originate service in Montgomery or Bucks Counties, AS AMENDED. A-2021-3025888 at PUC utility code no. 6424143.
3. PUC Enforcement Officer Freda Culver attempted several times to contact Respondent by phone advising of the need for a Safety Fitness Review. 5/20/22 After several attempts to contact Ilonze Transportation Services Officer Culver spoke with owner (Kenechukwu Ilonze). He stated that he was no longer in business and did not know if he would go back in business. Officer Culver asked if he had contacted the Public Utility Commission to let them know he was cancelling his Authority. He said his authority was suspended by the PUC on 3/31/22, Officer Culver then sent him the Abandonment Form to cancel his authority and to e-mail back to her. As of 6/07/22 there has been no contact from the carrier.
4. That Respondent, by failing to achieve a satisfactory evaluation on a safety fitness review, violated 66 Pa Code §501(c) and, for failure to maintain adequate, efficient, and safe service and facilities, violated 66 Pa Code §1501. The penalty for this violation is cancellation of the certificate held by Respondent with this Commission at utility code 6424143.

WHEREFORE, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement hereby requests that the Commission revoke the certificate of public convenience issued KENECHUKWU E ILONZE, T/A ILONZE TRANSPORTATION SERVICES at PUC utility code no. 6424143.



- B. If you fail to answer this complaint within twenty (20) days, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement will request that the Commission issue a Secretarial Letter imposing a penalty. The penalty could include a fine, the suspension or revocation of your certificate of public convenience or other remedy.
- C. If you file an Answer, which admits or fails to deny the allegations of the Complaint, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement will request that the Commission issue a Secretarial Letter imposing a penalty.
- D. If you file an Answer which contests the Complaint, the matter will be assigned to an Administrative Law Judge for hearing and decision. The judge is not bound by the optional fine set forth above.
