ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On April 1, 2022, PECO Energy Company (PECO), Utility Code 110550, filed Supplement No. 30 to Tariff Electric Pa. P.U.C. No. 1S (Supplement No. 30), to become effective May 31, 2022. On April 22, 2022, PECO filed Supplement No. 31 to Tariff Electric Pa. P.U.C. No. 1S voluntarily postponing the effective date until June 17, 2022.

PECO stated that the proposed tariff changes to its billing service options enable it to recover all implementation costs to facilitate Standard Offer Program (SOP) web-enrollment during the revised DSP-V period through a purchase of receivables (POR) discount. PECO also stated that it proposed to set the POR discount rate in its electric generation supplier tariff to 0.1% to recover the implementation costs incurred for SOP web-enrollment. PECO further stated that the changes made under the proposed tariff filing would not affect its revenues or expenses.

PECO submitted that its filing was made in accordance with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's (Commission) Order on PECO's Default Service Program for the period from June 1, 2021, through May 31, 2025, at Docket No. P-2020-3019290. PECO also submitted that, consistent with the Commission's Order, it provided a cost estimate for SOP web-enrollment to the Joint Petitioners on March 29, 2022. PECO further submitted that it received a response of "no objections" from the Joint Petitioners.

PECO serves approximately 1,688,116 customers as of January 2022. PECO served Supplement No. 30 on the Commission's Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement, the Office of Consumer Advocate, and the Office of Small Business Advocate. No complaints have been filed and no hearings held.

The Commission agrees that the tariff changes are consistent with the Commission's December 3, 2020 Order at Docket No. P-2020-3019290. Upon review of Supplement No. 30, we find that the proposed modifications contained therein do not appear to be unlawful, unjust, unreasonable, or contrary to the public interest.

Accordingly, we permit Supplement No. 30 to become effective on June 17, 2022. However, approval of this filing does not constitute a determination that this filing is lawful, just, or reasonable, but only that further investigation or suspension does not appear to be warranted at this time; **THEREFORE,**

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That PECO Energy Company Supplement No. 30 to Tariff Electric Pa. P.U.C. No. 1S is hereby permitted to become effective on June 17, 2022.

2. That this Order is without prejudice to any issues that may be raised by any party with respect to the tariff changes implemented by Supplement No. 30 to Tariff Electric Pa. P.U.C. No. 1S in future proceedings.

3. That a copy of this Order be served on the Office of Consumer Advocate, the Office of Small Business Advocate, and the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement.
4. That the proceeding at Docket No. R-2022-3031714 be closed.
