Request for Extension of Comment Period

Dear Ms. Pereira:

On June 16, 2022, the Commission entered an Order in the above-captioned proceeding and directed Philadelphia Gas Works (PGW) to file and serve supplemental information on or before July 6, 2022. Comments were due 20 days after PGW filed and served the supplemental information. PGW requested and received an extension until July 21, 2022, to file its supplemental information. Thus, the due date for comments was extended to August 10, 2022.

On July 5, 2022, the Coalition for Affordable Utility Services and Energy Efficiency in Pennsylvania (CAUSE-PA) filed a Petition requesting a 20-day extension of the comment period in the above-captioned proceeding. CAUSE-PA asserts that it has multiple conflicting deadlines as well as staffing limitations which inhibit its ability to meet the current deadline of August 10, 2022. CAUSE-PA submits that the additional 20 days would allow it to provide an adequate review and comment to the Commission's Order. CAUSE-PA Request for Extension at 1.

CAUSE-PA notes that the Office of Consumer Advocate and the Tenant Union Representative Network have indicated that they support its request. CAUSE-PA also reports that PGW, the Office of Small Business Advocate, the Commission's Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement, and the Philadelphia Industrial and Commercial Gas Users Group have indicated they do not oppose this request. CAUSE-PA Request for Extension at 1.

CAUSE-PA's request for an extension is granted. All comments are due no later than August 30, 2022, and reply comments are due 15 days thereafter or September 14, 2022.
