Thank you. I would like to ask, please, how I can correct the record Docket No. C-2020-3019763 (*Lawrence Kinsley v. PPL Electric*), which is missing a number of previously filed documents important for my pending Exceptions.

These missing document include, for example, my:

- Amended Formal Complaint and Affidavit in Support of Formal Complaint, both filed on 6/10/21. This Complaint is cryptically listed under the efile Daily Actions as "Restricted on Web {5F870819-86B8-C2DB-877D-79F679500000}."
- Trial Memorandum (eFile Confirmation Number 372963), submitted on 3/10/22.

The latter was a pre-trial memorandum which Judge Buckley, for unexplained reasons, considered a prohibited post-trial brief even though his order dismissing this case concedes that this Memorandum was filed before the hearing. Although he struck it as post-trial brief, it is a prime example of the arbitrary, capricious rulings at issue in my Exceptions, and thus, I believe, should be available for review of the Exceptions. So should my Motion for Reconsideration which sets the record straight about these facts, but which also was stricken.

Incorrectly, someone has labeled my Trial Memorandum my "main brief." It could well me that I am being set up to appear as though I am now stripped of my "main" contentions.

The striking of my Trial Memorandum and Motion for Reconsideration amount to "censoring" of the record, a harsh measure since nothing in the stricken documents is inflammatory, sensationalistic, nor violative of private information. The Commission, I believe, should have access to the full record in this case, not just the disputed facts to which I take exception. I am reminded in a sense George Orwell's 1984, where "Every record has been destroyed or falsified, every book rewritten, every picture has been repainted, every statue and street building has been renamed, every date has been altered. History has stopped."

Similarly, as part of my Exceptions, I would ask the Commission to decide my corrections of the 3/10/22 transcript which I submitted on 5/2/22, well before the 6/15/22 dismissal of this case. Obviously, this corrigenda should have been decided before the case was dismissed. I noted the corrigenda in the initial version of my Exceptions, but mistakenly overlooked this detail in my Amended Exceptions.
