Re: Petition of Philadelphia Gas Works for Emergency Order; Compliance Filing

Dear Mr. Clearfield:

On July 5, 2022, Philadelphia Gas Works (PGW or the Company) filed Supplement No. 151 to Gas Service Tariff – Pa. P.U.C. No. 2 to become effective on July 5, 2022. The supplement was filed in compliance with the Commission’s Emergency Order granted July 1, 2022, at Docket No. P-2022-3033477, permitting PGW to file its revised tariff, attached to the Petition as Appendix A, to go into effect immediately to eliminate the Company’s previously approved Weather Normalization Adjustment Clause for May 2022 usage billed as a charge in/for June 2022 residential and commercial billing cycles, subject to further investigation by the Commission. The Emergency Order was ratified by the Commission by Ratification Order entered July 14, 2022.

Commission Staff has reviewed the tariff revisions and found that suspension or further investigation does not appear warranted at this time. Therefore, in accordance with 52 Pa. Code Chapter 53, Supplement No. 151 to Gas Service Tariff – Pa. P.U.C. No. 2 is effective by operation of law as of the effective date contained on each page of the supplement. However, this is without prejudice to any formal complaints timely filed against said tariff revisions.
