Dear Ms. Schultz:

By Order entered May 12, 2022, the Commission authorized the City of Lancaster Bureau of Water (the Company) to file the tariff supplement containing the rates, rules and regulations as presented in Appendix A to the Joint Petition filed in the above docketed rate investigation, designed to produce an increase in annual operating revenues of approximately \$2,500,000 for Outside City Service. On June 24, 2022, the Company filed Supplement No. 48 to Tariff Water - Pa. P.U.C. No. 6 to become effective June 29, 2022.

Commission Staff has reviewed the tariff revisions and found that suspension or further investigation does not appear warranted at this time. Therefore, in accordance with 52 Pa. Code Chapter 53, Supplement No. 48 to Tariff Water - Pa. P.U.C. No. 6 is effective by operation of law as of the effective date contained on each page of the supplement. However, this is without prejudice to any formal complaints timely filed against said tariff revisions.
