On July 14, 2022, the Commission entered an Order in the above-captioned proceeding and directed PPL Electric Utilities Corporation (PPL) to file and serve supplemental information on or before August 3, 2022. Comments were due 20 days after PPL files and serves the supplemental information.


On July 21, 2022, the Coalition for Affordable Utility Services and Energy Efficiency in Pennsylvania (CAUSE-PA) filed a Petition requesting a 30-day extension of the comment period in the above-captioned proceeding. CAUSE-PA asserts that it has multiple conflicting deadlines as well as staffing limitations which inhibit its ability to meet the anticipated current deadline of August 23, 2022, for comments. CAUSE-PA submits that the additional 30 days would allow it to provide an adequate review and comment to the Commission's Order. CAUSE-PA Request for Extension at 1.

CAUSE-PA notes that the Office of Consumer Advocate, the Commission on Economic Opportunity, and the Coalition of Local Energy Efficiency Contractors have indicated that they support its request. CAUSE-PA Request for Extension at 1. To date, no one opposes the extension.

CAUSE-PA's request for an extension is granted. All comments are due no later than September 22, 2022, and reply comments are due 15 days thereafter or October 7, 2022.
