On July 22, 2022, the Complainant in the above captioned complaint case submitted a second set of Exceptions and a Petition for Reconsideration. The filing is rejected.

First, under 52 Pa. Code Sections 5.533 and 5.535, Parties to a proceeding may file exceptions and reply exceptions to the Initial Decision of the Administrative Law Judge. Both the Complainant and the Respondent filed timely exceptions and reply exceptions. The Complainant then filed Amended Exceptions and Motion on July 8, 2022, to which the Respondent answered. On July 15, 2022, the Commission responded denying the Complainant's Amended Exceptions and Motion noting the Commission's regulations do not allow for these extended pleadings. *See attached Secretarial Letter dated July 15, 2022*.

Second, the Complainant also filed a Petition for Reconsideration on July 22, 2022. This type of filing is premature since the complaint has not yet been finally adjudicated by the Commission. Petitions for Reconsideration must be filed within 15 days of the entry date of the Commission's final order in accordance with 52 Pa. Code Section 5.572.

Therefore, no further filings will be accepted in this case which is now pending before the Commission for a final decision, and the Complainant's filing of July 22, 2022, is rejected.
