Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

Philadelphia Gas Works (“PGW”) requests an additional 15 days in which to respond to the Complaint which was filed on July 15, 2022. By Secretarial Letter dated July 17, 2022, PGW’s response was due on August 8, 2022. The fifteen (15) day extension would move the due date for answer to August 23, 2022.

PGW requests the extension in order to have time to review and update its records and documents associated with the incident which is the subject of the complaint, given the time that has passed since the incident in question and the initial investigation, and because PGW is involved in another major PUC matter the trial of which is scheduled to begin on August 9, 2022.

PGW has communicated this request to counsel for the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement and she has indicated that I & E does not oppose a fifteen day extension.
