1. Reference Application, Section 1.c, Regulatory Contact – Applicant failed to provide a title for its regulatory contact. Please provide an updated application page with the appropriate corrections.
2. Reference Application, Section 1.e, Customer Complaints Contact Info – Applicant failed to list the titles for its primary and alternate contact for complaints and customer service. The application requires the full contact information for a primary and an alternate contact. Please provide an updated application page with the appropriate corrections.
3. Reference Application, Section 2.b, Chief Officers – Applicant failed to provide its chief officers names and addresses. Please provide an updated application page with the requested information.
4. Reference Application, Section 3.b, Predecessors – Applicant erroneously listed its cancelled license as a predecessor. Information regarding its cancelled licenses should be listed in Section 5.c. Please file an updated application page with the appropriate corrections.
5. Reference Application, Section 4.b, Proposed Operations – Applicant indicated that it proposes to operate as a Broker/Marketer but failed to indicate that it would not be taking title to the electricity nor making payments for customers. Please file an updated application page with the appropriate corrections.
6. Reference Application, Section 4.f, Start Date – Applicant listed a start date of 02/02/2022, but stated in Section 4.a that it was not presently doing business within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. Please update your start date to be a future date, or upon approval of the application.
7. Reference Application, Section 5.c, Customer/Regulatory/Prosecutory Actions – Applicant failed to list the cancellation of its prior NGS License (Docket No. A-2014-2441030) for non-payment of its Annual Fees. Please file an updated application page with the requested information.
8. Reference Application, Section 7.a, Financial Fitness – Applicant provided a bond in which it lists its name as Front Line Power Solutions LLC. The PA Department of State stated that the applicant’s registered name is Front Line Power Solutions, LLC (containing a comma). Please provide an updated financial security in which the applicant’s name is listed as Front Line Power Solutions, LLC exactly.

9. Reference Application, Section 7.b, Financial Fitness – Please provide a Profit and Loss statement for 2021 and three recent consecutive months of bank statements.
10. Reference Application, Section 7.f, Taxation – Applicant failed to provide a Revenue ID Number. Please resubmit a complete Tax Certification Statement.
11. Reference Application, Section 8.a, Technical Fitness – Applicant failed to provide a license for each state in which it operates in the electric or natural gas industries. Please provide the missing documentation.
12. Reference Application, Section 11.a, Application Affidavit – The Application Affidavit submitted lists the Office of the Affiant as John T. Holmes rather than CEO/Owner. Please resubmit the Application Affidavit with the appropriate corrections.
13. Reference Application, Section 12, Notarized Proofs – Applicant provided a notarized proof of publication for the Johnstown Tribune-Democrat in which the ad was folded up and unreadable. Please provide a legible notarized proof of publication for the above newspaper.
