On August 2, 2022, PPL Electric Utilities Corporation (PPL Electric) filed a Letter of Notification (LON) for approval to rebuild a section of the Saegers-Elimsport/Saegers-Clinton 230 kV Transmission Line Lycoming County, Pennsylvania. In order for us to complete our analysis of the subject application, the Bureau of Technical Utility Services requires answers to the enclosed data requests. This information is necessary for completion of our review of the filing.

Please forward the requested information to the Secretary of the Commission **within ten (10) days** of receipt of this letter. Failure to respond may result in the LON being denied. As well, if PPL Electric has decided to withdraw its filing, please reply notifying the Commission of such a decision.

All documents requiring notary stamps must have original signatures. The Commission strongly encourages submission through efilings with the Secretary of the Commission by opening an efilings account through the Commission's website and accepting eservice at <https://efiling.puc.pa.gov>. The Commission is accepting all public documents through our efilings system at this time.

If your filing contains confidential material, you are required to either file by overnight delivery or submit to the Secretary's Share Point File system to ensure the timely filing of your submission. Filers should contact the Secretary's Bureau in advance to gain access to the Share Point File system. Make sure to reference the Docket Number listed above when filing your response and mark the materials "CONFIDENTIAL" in bold or highlighted manner if any of the requested information is deemed to be of a confidential nature.

- A-1 Reference the Letter of Notification, Page 2. Please explain why PPL Electric is filing the Letter of Notification approximately 11 months prior to the construction date. Additionally, please provide the approximate date by which PPL Electric is seeking the Commission's decision.
- A-2 Reference the Letter of Notification, Paragraph 18. Please explain whether the assessment included structures to be replaced under the proposed project. If not, please provide a detailed explanation as to the relevance of the 2013 assessment on the proposed project.
- A-3 Reference the Letter of Notification, Paragraph 23, first sentence. Please provide a copy of the RTR Assessment contracted in May 2022.
- A-4 Reference the Letter of Notification, Paragraph 23. Please provide a copy of the RTR September 2021 Assessment.
- A-5 Reference the Letter of Notification, Paragraph 29. The stated cost is not consistent with the cost stated on PJM Interconnection, LLC's Project Status & Cost Allocation page. Please explain.
- A-6 Reference the Letter of Notification, Paragraph 31. Please quantify the anticipated increase in reliability in terms of customer average interruption duration index, system average interruption duration index, and system average frequency index.
- A-7 Reference the Letter of Notification, Section VII. Please provide an updated page with the statement required by 52 Pa Code § 57.72(d)(4)(iv).
- A-8 Reference the Letter of Notification. Please provide a five-year history of maintenance expenses for transmission facilities to be replaced as part of the proposed project.
- A-9 Reference the Letter of Notification. Please provide information regarding any unplanned outages on the subject transmission facilities over the previous 5 years (or more), including the duration, cause, whether service to customers was interrupted by outages on the subject transmission line, and if so, the number and type of customers which were impacted. Additionally, explain whether the proposed project would mitigate the effects of these outages.
