To Whom It May Concern:

The purpose of this Letter is to advise you that your application has been reviewed and approved by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission). However, before you begin operations, you must file with the Commission all of the information listed in paragraphs (a) below. **You cannot operate under the approved motor carrier rights set forth in this Letter until all of the information listed below is filed with, and approved by, the Commission.** Once the information listed below is received and approved by the Commission, you will receive a Certificate of Public Convenience, with PUC No. A-6425306 which authorizes you to begin operating under the motor carrier rights set forth in this Letter.

- a. **An acceptable Form E filed by an insurance company which is binding evidence of bodily injury liability insurance. Your insurance company must file these forms with the exact name of the applicant as it appears on this Letter – SPECIAL DELIVERY MOBILITY LLC. The State MC A-6425306 must be listed to identify your account. All service types covered by this policy must be listed. Insurance filings are accepted online via NIC Insurance Filings at www.nicinsurancefilings.com.**
- b. **Tariff already accepted and in place.**

Applicants are responsible for monitoring their account online. You can do this by visiting the following web address: <https://www.puc.pa.gov/search/utility-authority-search/>. Enter your

company name, click submit, then click on your utility code hyperlink. Navigate to the “Insurance Info” tab, where you can view accepted forms.

FAILURE TO FILE THE ABOVE REQUIRED EVIDENCE OF INSURANCE WITHIN SIXTY (60) DAYS OF THE DATE OF THIS LETTER CAN RESULT IN THE DISMISSAL OF THE APPLICATION AND REQUIRE THE FILING OF A NEW APPLICATION AND FILING FEE.


Upon issuance of a Certificate of Public Convenience you are granted the right to operate as follows:

To transport non-ambulatory persons, solely on secured stretchers, as a common carrier, by motor vehicle, in nonambulance, nonemergency and nonmedical paratransit service in a stretcher van, from points in the Counties of Bucks, Chester, Delaware and Montgomery, and the City and County of Philadelphia, to points in Pennsylvania, and return. (AS AMENDED)

You should become familiar with the requirements of 52 Pa. Code as applicable to the operation of a common carrier as authorized by this grant of authority. Any change in address must be reported to the Commission by filing a Change of Address Form. This form can be found on the Commission's website. Failure to comply with all applicable requirements may subject the carrier to penalties, including fines, suspension of operating rights or cancellation of authority. Title 52 of the Pennsylvania Code may be accessed at www.pacode.com.

If you are dissatisfied with the resolution of this matter, you may, as set forth in 52 Pa. Code §5.44, file a petition with the Commission within twenty (20) days of the date of this Letter.
