Re: Nuclear Decommissioning Cost Adjustment and Proposed Changes to Electric Tariff No. 7


Dear Mr. Webster:

On March 31, 2022, PECO Energy Company (PECO) filed an updated Nuclear Decommissioning Cost Adjustment (NDCA) to reflect updated cost studies, fund balances and license extensions. The NDCA is updated every five years as required by PECO's Restructuring Settlement docketed at R-00973953. The proposed tariff supplement makes no changes to the current NDCA credit value of (\$0.0006) per kWh.

Commission Staff has reviewed the proposed tariff supplement and supporting information filed in accordance with PECO's Tariff Electric Pa P.U.C. No. 7 NDCA clause and found that suspension or further investigation does not appear warranted at this time. **Therefore, PECO is directed to file a tariff supplement on at least 10 days-notice to implement the proposed rate effective January 1, 2023.**
