Dear Mr. Ferenchak:

By Order adopted at Public Meeting held April 14, 2022, at Docket Nos. A-2021-3030129, and A-2021-3030138, the Commission approved the application of Vero Fiber Networks, LLC (Company) to operate in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania as a Competitive Local Exchange Carrier in the service territories of all thirty-five ILECs and as a Competitive Access Provider (statewide). In order to receive Certificates of Public Convenience to provide these services, the Commission directed the Company to file initial tariffs containing the revisions provided in Appendix A of the Order. On May 25, 2022, the Company filed Tariff Telephone-Pa. P.U.C. Nos. 1, 2 and 3 with an effective date of May 26, 2022.

Commission Staff has reviewed the tariffs and found them to be in compliance with the Commission's Order. Therefore, Tariff Telephone-Pa. P.U.C. No. 1, Tariff Telephone-Pa. P.U.C. No. 2 and Tariff Telephone-Pa. P.U.C. No. 3 have been permitted to become effective as filed. This permission does not constitute a determination that the tariffs are just, lawful or reasonable, but only that suspension or further investigation does not appear to be warranted at this time, and is without prejudice to any formal complaints timely filed against said tariffs.

As directed by the Order, the Company is required to add its Pennsylvania tariffs to its website within thirty (30) days of receipt of the enclosed Certificates of Public Convenience. Upon placing the tariffs on its website, the Company shall contact Cyndi Page ((717) 787-5722; cypage@pa.gov) of the Commission's Office of Communications to inform her of the tariffs website address. In order to maintain a true and accurate representation of its tariffs on file with the Commission, the Company is required to continually update its tariffs whenever supplemental revisions are approved by the Commission.

Further, please be advised that Commission Staff makes no determination whether the Company's switched access rates are in compliance with Act 183, P.L. 1398 (66 Pa. C.S. § 3017(c)).
