On June 1, 2022, Duquesne Light Company (DLC) filed a Petition seeking approval of its Second Long-Term Infrastructure Improvement Plan (LTIIIP). The 120-day LTIIIP consideration period outlined in the Commission's Final Implementation Order would have ended on October 1, 2022.<sup>1</sup> However, in order to fully evaluate the instant LTIIIP, the Commission is hereby extending its review period until October 31, 2022.
