SECTION 1

RULES & REGULATIONS

ITEM 20 - GOVERNING PUBLICATIONS

For rates, rules, regulations, and provisions applicable to the transportation of household goods, in use, except as otherwise provided herein, see Tariff Freight PA. P. U. C. No. 53 (Carrier Directory), loose-leaf revisions thereto and successive issues thereof, issued by Tristate Household Goods Tariff Conference, Inc., Agent.

ITEM 30 - CLASSIFICATION OF PROPERTY

Class 1 shipments are personal effects and property used or to be used in a dwelling when a part of the equipment or supply of such dwelling and such other similar property; except that this subparagraph shall not be construed to include property moving from a factory or store, except such property as the householder has purchased with the intent to use in his dwelling and which is transported at the request of, and the transportation charges paid to the carrier by the householder.

ITEM 40 - DECLARED VALUE

Rates and charges named herein are applicable when value declared by shipper does not exceed sixty (60) certs per pound, per article. For method of determining rates when value declared exceeds sixty (60) cents per pound, per article, see Conversion Table of Rates, Section V of Governing Tariff.

HOURLY RATES

Subject to Notes 1 to 7 below, the transportation charges on any shipment shall be a <u>COMBINATION</u> of the applicable <u>TRAVELING CHARGE</u> named in Column 1 plus HOURLY CHARGE at applicable rates named in Columns 2, 3, and 4.

Hourly rates apply from the time of arrival to the first point of origin (continued during all loading, transportation from the first point of origin, as well as any extra stops, to the final destination & unloading and dismissal of vehicle and men by the shipper at the final destination.

Traveling charges covers traveling from the mover's base facility to the first point of origin and returning from the final destination back to the mover's base facility.

- NOTE 2 Hourly rates (Columns 2, 3, and 4) are based on the day or days as indicated, during which services are performed.
- NOTE 3 Hourly rates (Columns 2, 3, and 4) computed in half-hour periods; fractions of one-half hour will be considered as one-half hour.
- NOTE 4 When a holiday falls on a Saturday, the rates named in Columns 1 and 2 shall be applicable.
- NOTE 5 Minimum total transportation charges: Sundays and Holidays (any hour): four (4) hours at rates named in Columns 1 and 2.

Weekdays, 8:00AM to 5:00PM: three (3) hours at rates named in Columns 1 and 3. Weekdays, 5:01PM to 7:59AM, and Saturdays (any hour):

three (3) hours at rates named in Columns 1 and 4.

NOTE 6 - Carrier will supply and charge for supervisor or supervisors as requested by shipper. Rate for each supervisor will be computed from time of arrival of vehicles and men at the first point of origin until completion of unloading and dismissal of vehicles and men at the final destination unless other time of arrival or dismissal is provided by agreement between the shipper and the carrier.

NOTE 7 - When shipment is held overnight, at the convenience of the shipper, carrier will access an additional charge of \$100.00 per truck per night. This charge will apply to shipments traveling between points in Pennsylvania and transported 40 miles and less or transported in excess of 40 miles.
