Dear Mr. Berry:

By Order entered July 14, 2022, the Commission authorized Philadelphia Gas Works (the Company) to file a tariff supplement to reflect rates and terms consistent with the terms of the Joint Petition for Settlement filed in the above docketed rate investigation and the Order to be effective for services rendered on or after September 1, 2022, subject to quarterly adjustments permitted by Commission regulations at 52 Pa. Code § 53.64(i)(5), to reflect actual experience and changes in forecasted natural gas prices. On August 26, 2022, the Company filed Supplement No. 153 to Gas Service Tariff - Pa. P.U.C. No. 2, and Supplement No. 102 to Gas Supplier Tariff – Pa. P.U.C. No. 1, to become effective September 1, 2022.

Commission Staff has reviewed the tariff revisions and found that suspension or further investigation does not appear warranted at this time. Therefore, in accordance with 52 Pa. Code Chapter 53, the supplements are effective by operation of law as of the effective dates contained on each page of the supplements. However, this is without prejudice to any formal complaints timely filed against said tariff revisions.
