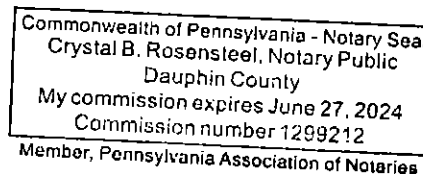

**Application of Reliable Power Alternatives Corporation For Approval To Offer, Render, or Furnish Natural Gas Services as a Supplier, Aggregator, or Marketer/Broker Engaged In The Business Of Supplying Natural Gas Supply Services, To The Public In The Commonwealth Of Pennsylvania.**

Reliable Power Alternatives Corporation will be filing an application with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("PUC") for a license to provide natural gas supply services as (1) a supplier or aggregator of natural gas, and (2) a broker/marketer engaged in the business of providing natural gas services. Reliable Power Alternatives Corporation proposes to sell natural gas and related services throughout all of Pennsylvania under the provisions of the new Natural Gas Choice and Competition Act.

The PUC may consider this application without a hearing. Protests directed to the technical or financial fitness of Reliable Power Alternatives Corporation may be filed within 15 days of the date of this notice with the Secretary of the PUC, 400 North Street, Harrisburg, PA 17120. We are pleased that Reliable Power Alternatives Corp. has applied for a license to provide Natural Gas Broker/Marketer Services on the distribution system of Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania, Inc. ("Columbia Gas").

*Under Paragraph 2.4.5 of the Rules Applicable to Distribution Service section of the Tariff of Columbia Gas, Reliable Power Alternatives Corp. could be required to provide to Columbia Gas a bond or other financial security instrument in an amount that Columbia Gas determines to be appropriate. Reliable Power Alternatives Corp. has indicated only brokering and consulting services will be provided. Therefore, we have determined at this time that Reliable Power Alternatives Corp. does not need a bond or other financial security requirement to provide broker natural gas services to Columbia Gas customers.*

If the creditworthiness requirement or Columbia Gas' exposure to Reliable Power Alternatives Corp. changes in the future, Columbia Gas might deem it appropriate to require Reliable Power Alternatives Corp. to provide a bond or other financial security instrument.

National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation ("NFGDC") is aware Reliable Power Alternatives Corp. (RPAC) has filed an application with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission to supply natural gas service to the public in Pennsylvania and specifically within the service territory of NFGDC.

As you know, in making such an application, RPAC must furnish acceptable security to each utility where RPAC will do business. As such, under its tariff, NFGDC could require RPAC to provide a bond or other financial security instrument in an amount that NFGDC determines to be appropriate.

However, you have indicated, and it is NFGDC's understanding that RPAC intends only to provide natural gas aggregating, brokering and consulting services at this time. You have stated that, in performing these services, RPAC will never take title to any delivered natural gas, nor will it accept any customer payments or deposits.

Based upon your representations, NFGDC has determined that, at this time, RPAC does not need to post a bond or other form of security to operate in its service territory. However, if the services provided by RPAC change in the future, NFGDC reserves the right to require security from RPAC as it deems appropriate.

Dear Reliable Power Alternatives Corp.:

PECO is aware that Reliable Power Alternatives Corp. has applied for a license to provide brokering and consulting services to commercial and industrial customers on the distribution system of PECO.

In making such an application Reliable Power Alternatives Corp. could be required to provide to PECO a bond or other acceptable financial security in an amount that PECO determines to be appropriate. Reliable Power Alternatives Corp. has indicated that it intends to provide only brokering and consulting services to commercial and industrial customers will not take title to any delivered natural gas; nor will accept any customer payments or deposits.

Therefore, PECO has determined at this time that Reliable Power Alternatives Corp. does not need a bond or other financial security requirement, since they are not directly engaging in business with PECO and only providing brokering or consulting services to PECO customers. However, if the services provided by Reliable Power Alternatives Corp. or the creditworthiness requirement for PECO's exposure to Reliable Power Alternatives Corp. changes in the future, PECO reserves the right to require Reliable Power Alternatives Corp. to provide a bond or other financial security instrument.

Based on your assertion that Reliable Power Alternatives Corp. ("Reliable Power") is applying with the State of Pennsylvania to operate as a natural gas broker/marketer, UGI Utilities, Inc.-Gas Division ("UGIU") has concluded that Reliable Power will not need to post security with UGIU.
