On August 29, 2022, PPL Electric Utilities Corporation (PPL Electric) filed a Letter of Notification (LON) for approval to reconstruct the South Akron-Millwood 230 kV Transmission Line in Lancaster County, Pennsylvania. In order for us to complete our analysis of the subject application, the Bureau of Technical Utility Services requires answers to the enclosed data requests. This information is necessary for completion of our review of the filing.

Please forward the requested information to the Secretary of the Commission **within ten (10) days** of receipt of this letter. Failure to respond may result in the LON being denied. As well, if PPL Electric has decided to withdraw its filing, please reply notifying the Commission of such a decision.

All documents requiring notary stamps must have original signatures. The Commission strongly encourages submission through efilings with the Secretary of the Commission by opening an efilings account through the Commission's website and accepting eservice at <https://efiling.puc.pa.gov>. The Commission is accepting all public documents through our efilings system at this time.

If your filing contains confidential material, you are required to either file by overnight delivery or submit to the Secretary's Share Point File system to ensure the timely filing of your submission. Filers should contact the Secretary's Bureau in advance to gain access to the Share Point File system. Make sure to reference the Docket Number listed above when filing your response and mark the materials "CONFIDENTIAL" in bold or highlighted manner if any of the requested information is deemed to be of a confidential nature.


Your answers should be verified per 52 Pa Code § 1.36. Accordingly, you must provide the following statement with your responses:

- A-1 Reference the Letter of Notification, Paragraph 22. Please provide a copy of the assessment prepared by RTR Solutions in April 2022.
- A-2 Reference the Letter of Notification, Paragraph 25. Please state the number of critical customers served by the facilities to be replaced under the subject project.
- A-3 Reference the Letter of Notification, Paragraph 29. Please explain whether PPL Electric will replace the conductors along the entire length of the proposed project.
- A-4 Reference the Letter of Notification, Paragraph 30. Please quantify the anticipated increase in reliability in terms of customer average interruption duration index, system average interruption duration index, and system average interruption frequency index.
- A-5 Reference the Letter of Notification, Attachment 1, page 2. Please provide information regarding any unplanned outages on the subject transmission facilities over the previous 5 years (or more), including the duration, cause, whether service to customers was interrupted by outages on the subject transmission line, and if so, the number and type of customers which were impacted. Additionally, explain whether the proposed project would mitigate the effects of these outages.
- A-6 Reference the Letter of Notification, Attachment 1, page 2. Please provide a five-year history of maintenance expenses for transmission facilities to be replaced as part of the proposed project.
- A-7 Reference the Letter of Notification, Attachment 1, page 2. Please explain why PPL Electric is filing the Letter of Notification 11 months prior to the estimated construction start date. Additionally, please provide the approximate date by which PPL Electric is seeking a Commission decision.
- A-8 Reference the Letter of Notification, Attachment 2, page 3. Please explain whether any structures will be placed on properties or easements that did not previously have a structure. If so, state whether the easement agreement allows for structures on these properties. Additionally, explain PPL Electric's process for informing the property owners that a structure will be placed on the easement to their property.
