Code § 1.82, NOW COMES the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement (“I&E”) of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) to hereby submit this Petition to Withdraw the Joint Petition for Approval of Settlement to resolve all issues related to the above-docketed I&E Formal Complaint proceeding.

As Lower Heidelberg Township (hereinafter “Respondent”) paid the agreed-upon administrative penalty, pursuant to 73 P.S. § 182.10(b), on April 6, 2022, as well as took corrective action in that Respondent participated in the March 17, 2022 PUC Compliance Training for Facility Owners and Locators, it is I&E’s position that the above-docketed complaint is satisfied and should be marked closed, as indicated by the Certificate of Satisfaction, filed pursuant to Section 5.24 of the Commission’s regulations, 52 Pa.
