**Re: Annual Asset Optimization Plan (AAOP) for the Philadelphia Gas Works (PGW) – Docket No. M-2021-3029293**

Dear Mr. Berry:

On October 27, 2021, Philadelphia Gas Works (PGW) filed its Annual Asset Optimization Plan (AAOP), pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 121.6. The Commission approved PGW’s AAOP via a December 1, 2021, Secretarial Letter. On June 17, 2022, PGW filed a revised AAOP (Revised AAOP).

PGW explains that the Revised AAOP only updates certain project costs in its actual expenditures for 2021 and projected projects and project costs from its original AAOP filing. These updates do not alter the total actual and projected expenditures or main amounts from PGW’s original AAOP.

The Revised AAOP does not propose a Major Modification to the company’s LTIP. Accordingly, PGW’s Revised AAOP appears to substantially conform to the schedule set forth in the company’s LTIP.

**Conclusion**

Upon review of PGW’s Revised AAOP filed on June 17, 2022, it appears that the filing substantially complies with the requirements of 52 Pa. Code § 121.6 and it is approved. This approval is contingent upon the possibility that subsequent audits, reviews and inquiries, in any Commission proceeding, may be conducted pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 121.

If you are dissatisfied with the resolution of this matter, you may, as set forth in 52 Pa. Code § 5.44, file a petition with the Commission within twenty (20) days after the date of this letter.
