Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

In accordance with the Commission's June 16, 2022 Order issued in the above-captioned Dockets, PECO Energy Company ("PECO" or "the Company") hereby files this report detailing the final disbursement of the unspent 2020 Low Income Usage Reduction Program funds as grants issued by PECO's Matching Energy Assistance Fund ("MEAF") agencies.

In July, PECO compiled and verified the list of customers in each county that would be eligible, based on the Commission-approved criteria, to have their past-due balances eliminated by these grants. On August 10, 2022, PECO notified the MEAF agencies that the funds were ready to be dispersed and provided them with the list of grant recipients.

In late August, PECO also sent a letter to each recipient notifying them of the program, advising that they would be receiving a one-time grant that would bring their balance to \$0, and informing them about the Company's suite of universal service programs.

The chart below, broken down by county, reflects the beginning and ending dates for the disbursements, the number of grants issued, total amount dispersed, the minimum and maximum grants issued, and the average grant amount.
