To Whom It May Concern:

The purpose of this Letter is to advise you that your application has been reviewed and approved by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission). However, before you begin operations, you must file with the Commission all of the information listed in paragraphs (a) through (d) below. **You cannot operate under the approved motor carrier rights set forth in this Letter until all of the information listed below is filed with, and approved by, the Commission.** Once the information listed below is received and approved by the Commission, you will receive a Certificate of Public Convenience, with **PUC No. A-8925349**, which authorizes you to begin operating under the motor carrier rights set forth in this Letter.

- (a) **An acceptable Form E and Form H** filed by an insurance company which is binding evidence of bodily injury and property damage liability insurance. **Your insurance company must file these forms with the exact name of the applicant as it appears on this Letter – Jordan R. Dietrich. The State MC ID A-8925349 must be listed to identify your account. All service types covered by this policy must be listed.**
- (b) **An acceptable tariff, or tariff adoption supplement**, establishing just and reasonable rates. Please email your tariff draft for approval to RA-PCTARIFFFILING@pa.gov. DO NOT E-FILE an unapproved tariff.

APPLICANTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR MONITORING THEIR ACCOUNT ONLINE. You can do this by visiting the following web address: <https://www.puc.pa.gov/search/utility-authority-search/>. Enter your company name, click submit, then click on your utility code hyperlink. Navigate to the “Insurance Info” tab, where you can view accepted forms.

Upon issuance of a Certificate of Public Convenience you are granted the right to operate as follows:

*To transport, as a common carrier, by motor vehicle, household goods in use, **limited to transporting pianos**, between points in Pennsylvania.*

FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH ANY PROVISION OF THIS LETTER WITHIN SIXTY (60) DAYS OF THE DATE OF THIS LETTER WILL RESULT IN THE DISMISSAL OF THE APPLICATION AND REQUIRE THE FILING OF A NEW APPLICATION AND FILING FEE.


If you have not previously submitted a copy of a current satisfactory safety rating from the U.S. Department of Transportation or another state with safety regulations comparable to Pennsylvania, you must demonstrate safety fitness by completing a Safety Fitness Review which will be scheduled by a PUC enforcement officer within 180 days of the date your certificate of public convenience is issued/entered. **Failure to submit to the Safety Fitness Review will result in the cancellation of your certificate.** An overview of the safety regulations for carriers of people, property, and household goods between points in Pennsylvania can be found on the PUC's Website: <http://www.puc.pa.gov/> then select: Filing & Resources, Forms, Motor Carrier Forms, Safety Fitness Compliance.

The applicant is hereby advised of its obligation to familiarize itself with the requirements of 52 Pa. Code as applicable to the operation of a common carrier as authorized by this Secretarial Letter. Applicant is further advised that failure to comply with all applicable requirements may subject the carrier to penalties, including fines, suspension of operating rights or cancellation of its authority. Title 52 of the Pennsylvania Code is available online at www.pacode.com.

Any PUC motor carrier who needs to submit a change of address to the Public Utility Commission, can obtain the Change of Address form from the PUC Website: <http://www.puc.pa.gov/> then select: Filing & Resources, Forms, Motor Carrier Forms.

ALL Parties to proceedings pending before the Commission must open and use an e-filing account through the Commission's website, OR you may submit your filing by overnight delivery. If a filing contains confidential or proprietary material, the filing is required to be submitted by overnight delivery.
