Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

In accordance with PECO's Joint Petition for Settlement to its 2021 Electric Distribution Rate case, PECO cannot implement a new DSIC until at least April 1, 2023. Therefore, the Company's DSIC rate will remain a value of 0%. Since PECO cannot implement a new electric DSIC until April 2023, no DSIC calculation is being provided with the filing for the period of October 1, 2022 to December 31, 2022.

Also, in compliance with the Supplemental Order entered September 21, 2016 at Docket No. M-2012-2293611, PECO includes Attachment 1 which shows a comparison of actual DSIC-eligible plant vs. FPPTY.
