The Bureau of Audits has reviewed PPL Electric Utilities Corporation's proposed Supplement No. 343 to Tariff Electric – Pa. P.U.C. No. 201 and the supporting rate computations submitted on September 20, 2022, to become effective on October 1, 2022.

Based upon staff review, it appears that the proposed Distribution System Improvement Charge (DSIC) rate for the three-month period of October 1, 2022 through December 31, 2022 is consistent with the tariff and, accordingly, is permitted to become effective as filed.

The DSIC is subject to continuous Commission review and audit as well as reconciliation reports in accordance with Section 1307(e) of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. § 1307(e).
