On August 10, 2022, Interstate Gas Supply, Inc. filed an Annual Compliance Filing<sup>1</sup> to maintain its bonding level of 5% of its most recent 4 quarters of revenue subject to the minimum of \$250,000, per the Commission's Orders entered July 24, 2014, at Docket No. M-2013-2393141 and September 20, 2018, at Docket No. P-2017-2608078. In order for us to complete our analysis of your filing, the Energy Industry Group requires answers to the attached question(s).
