**PETITION OF THE BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION AND ENFORCEMENT FOR
LEAVE TO WITHDRAW COMPLAINT**

TO THE COMMISSION:

The Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement (“I&E”) of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission”), by and through its prosecuting attorney, pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.82(a), petitions for leave to withdraw the Formal Complaint (“Complaint”) in the above captioned proceeding. I&E submits the following in support thereof:


1. Metro Ride LLC (Metro) was issued a certificate of public convenience by this Commission at docket A-2018-3003019 for paratransit authority.
2. On September 22, 2022, I&E filed a Complaint docketed at C-2022-3035553 against Metro. In its Complaint, I&E alleged that Metro failed to satisfy its 2021-2022 Fiscal Year assessment balance in full after receiving notification of the balance it owed through an invoice served to it by the Commission. I&E alleged that Metro’s failure to pay its 2021-2022 Fiscal Year assessment was a violation of 66 Pa.C.S. § 510(c) of the Public Utility Code. For relief, I&E requested that Metro be ordered to pay a total of \$2,711, consisting of its outstanding assessment balance of \$2,357 and a total civil penalty of \$354 for Metro’s violation of the Code.

3. Following the filing of the Formal Complaint, Complainant was advised by the Commission's Bureau of Administrative Services that Respondent paid its 2021-2022 Fiscal Year assessment of \$2,357. The assessment was paid prior to the filing of the Formal Complaint.¹

4. Given the analysis above, Respondent has not violated any law which the Commission has jurisdiction to administer, or of any regulation or order of the Commission. The public interest is served by the withdrawal of the Formal Complaint filed at C-2022-3035553, as there is no case or controversy for the Commission to adjudicate.

WHEREFORE, for all the foregoing reasons, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement respectfully requests that the Commission grant this Petition.


