

 - a. Provide a fully executed agreement between Progressive Light & Power LLC and ESG;
 - b. Provide the agreement’s start and termination dates;
 - c. Provide the services, with descriptions and details, that will be performed by ESG and cite specifically where the services are in the agreement;
 - d. Provide ESG’s PJM and NYISO agreements and registrations;
 - e. Provide details of ESG’s other clients and the States where the same services, in the agreement, have been performed;
 - f. Provide a detailed description of the process, from start to finish, when a new customer is signed up with Progressive Light & Power LLC as a supplier through the time the customer is switched to Progressive Light & Power LLC;
 - g. Provide details on how a customer bill will be created.

3. Reference Application, Section 12, Notarized Proofs – Applicant failed to provide a recent notarized proof of publication for Scranton Times-Tribune. Please provide the missing notarized proof of publication.
4. Reference Reply to Data Request, Page 99 – Applicant provided a Gross Profit Margin chart that lists its gross profits from June 2021 to May 2022 in the territories of PECO, PPL, and Duquesne. Please explain what this chart represents.
