Infrastructure Improvement Plan

Dear Mr. Zimmerman:

On June 1, 2022, Duquesne Light Company (DLC) filed a Petition seeking approval of its Second Long-Term Infrastructure Improvement Plan (LTIIIP). The 120-day LTIIIP consideration period outlined in the Commission's Final Implementation Order would have ended on October 1, 2022.¹ However, in order to fully evaluate the instant LTIIIP, the Commission initially extended its review period until October 31, 2022. In order to evaluate additional information requested from DLC, the Commission is hereby extending the review period until November 30, 2022.

If you are dissatisfied with the resolution of this matter, you may, as set forth in 52 Pa. Code § 5.44, file a petition with the Commission within twenty (20) days after the date of this letter.
