

Code § 5.13 for the alteration of the public at grade crossing where Industrial Park Road crosses the tracks of R.J. Corman Railroad Company/Pennsylvania Lines, Inc at DOT Number 928 037 G in Lawrence Township, Clearfield County as described below:

1. The name and address of Applicant are Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of Transportation, Dean D. Ball, P.E., Assistant District Executive, Engineering District 2-0, 70 PennDOT Drive, Clearfield, PA 16830.

The Applicant is seeking approval to remove one set of tracks crossing Industrial Park Rd, relocate existing warning devices and perform full depth pavement reclamation adjacent to, and within the existing paved railroad crossing located on Industrial Park Road. A Location Map is attached hereto and marked as Exhibit “B”.

6. The Applicant is not aware of prior Public Utility Commission proceedings for this crossing.

7. The Applicant does not have an average daily traffic count for this crossing.

8. The estimated total cost for the project subject to the application and described above is \$1,292,207.00. The Applicant anticipates that the funding for the project may be federal funds and state funds.

9. This project is necessary and proper for the safety and convenience of the public.

10. A conference of all parties of interest should be held to discuss the proposed project

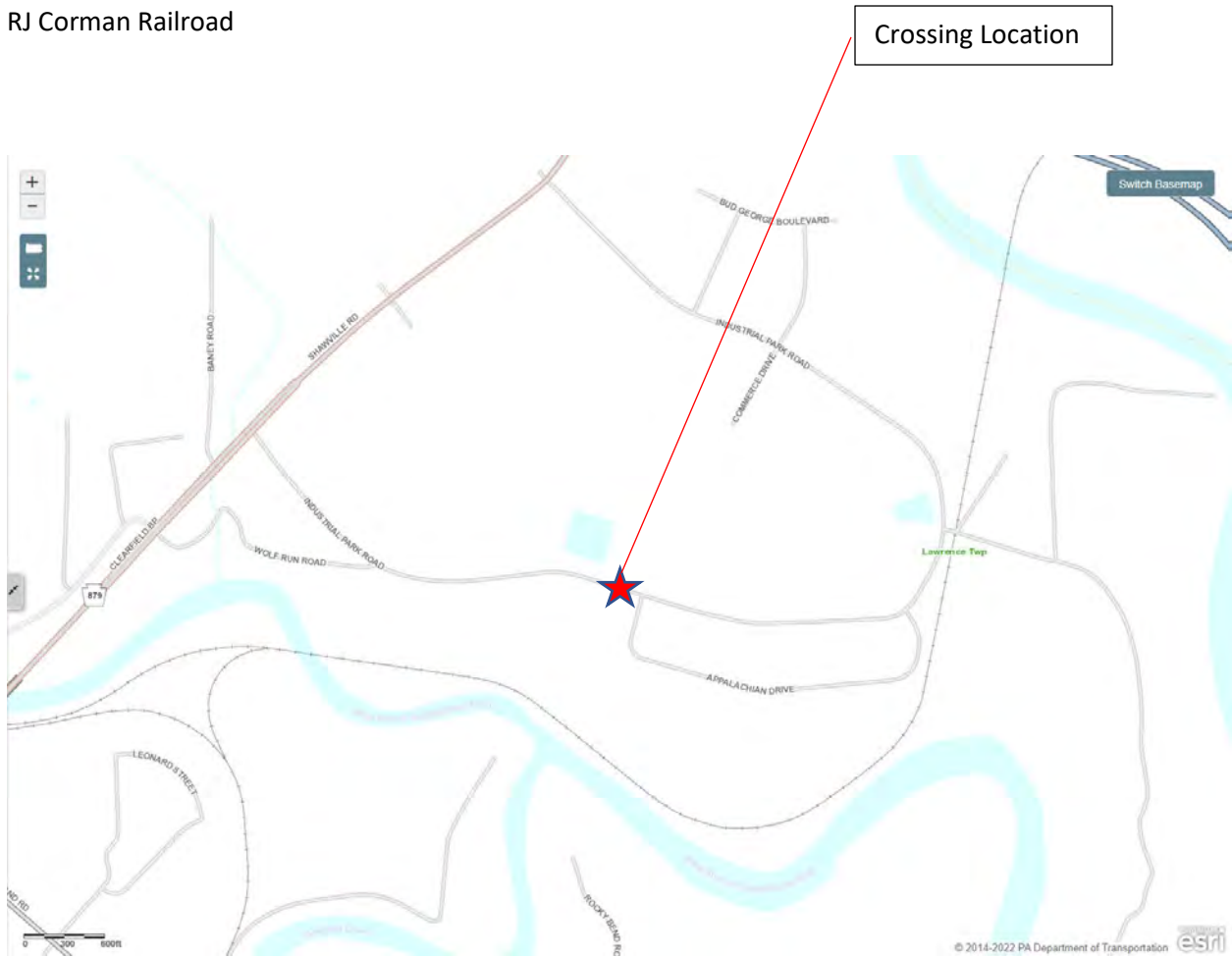
